### RAMAPPA TEMPLE PRESERVATION MUST BE GIVEN TOP PRIORITY: COLLECTOR

Mulugu, September 8 (TSIT):Mulugu District Collector Borkhade Hemanth Sahadeo Rao has directed officials to accord the highest priority to the preservation and protection of the historic Ramappa Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A meeting of the Palampet Special Development Authority Committee was held on Tuesday at the Video Conference Hall of the Integrated District Offices Complex under the chairmanship of the District Collector. The committee discussed in detail the precautionary measures required to ensure that the Kakatiya Rudreshwara (Ramappa) Temple is not affected by the open-cast mining activities proposed in the Venkatapur mandal area. The meeting also deliberated on the proposal to issue a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for the establishment of the open-cast mine.



### BRS stages protest against Congress government in Mancherial.

Mancherial, Sept. 8, TSIT : The Bharat Rashtara Samithi (BRS) on Tuesday staged a protest in Mancherial as part of its statewide agitation against the Congress government, alleging that the ruling party had failed to fulfil its election promises. The protest, led by BRS State leader Nadipelli Vijith Rao, saw a large number of party leaders and workers participate. The protesters alleged that the government had neglected the welfare of farmers, women, youth and other sections of society during its nearly 1,000-day tenure. The BRS leaders took out a rally through the district headquarters and staged a road blockade on the main road.



Later, they reached the Ambedkar statue, performed a milk abhishekam and submitted a memorandum highlighting their demands. Addressing the gathering, Mr. Vijith Rao alleged that the Congress had come to power by making a series of promises but had failed to implement them after assuming office. He demanded that the government fulfil its commitments to farmers, women and other sections of society.

### Collector directs banks to speed up loan disbursements

Jogulamba Gadwal TSIT. District Collector Rizwan Basha Shaik has directed bankers to ensure timely and adequate credit facilities to all eligible beneficiaries and accelerate loan disbursements under various government welfare and development schemes.



improved performance in sanctioning loans under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme and Kisan Credit Card (KCC) loans for fishermen. Reviewing the credit-deposit position, the Collector noted that the ratio stood at 228.74 per cent as on March 31 and 227.60 per cent as on June 30. He directed banks to accelerate lending operations and improve credit deployment. Under the priority sector, against a target of

Rs.5,743.98 crore, banks achieved Rs.3,463.10 crore (60.23 per cent) as of March 31. Against the revised target of Rs.6,495.02 crore as on June 30, only Rs.1,050.24 crore (16.17 per cent) had been achieved. In the agriculture sector, against the March 31 target of Rs.4,979.08 crore, banks achieved Rs.3,652.98 crore (73.37 per cent). Against the June 30 target of Rs.5,575.54 crore, only Rs.990.19 crore (17.75 per cent) was achieved. The Collector instructed bankers to substantially improve the pace of agricultural lending.

Similarly, in the MSME sector, banks achieved Rs.335.05 crore (55.29 per cent) against the March 31 target of Rs.606 crore, while only Rs.205.56 crore (29.71 per cent) was achieved against the June 30 target of Rs.691.80 crore. The Collector called for greater disbursement of MUDRA, housing and agriculture loans, besides expanding banking services in rural areas. He also directed officials to conduct extensive financial literacy programmes and increase public participation in such camps. He stressed the need to educate people about the risks and high interest burden associated with borrowing from non-banking financial institutions and private lenders. He suggested using videos, PowerPoint presentations and real-life experiences of affected borrowers to create greater awareness.

### Mahila Congress Demands Removal of BRS MLC Tata Madhu Over Remarks Against Speaker

Hyderabad, TSIT: Telangana Pradesh Mahila Congress on Tuesday demanded the immediate removal of BRS MLC Tata Madhu over his alleged objectionable and insulting remarks against Telangana Legislative Assembly Speaker Gaddam Prasad Kumar. Led by Telangana Pradesh Mahila Congress president Errabelli Swarna, women Congress leaders from Khairatabad, Secunderabad and Medhachhat staged a protest near the Dr B.R. Ambedkar statue at Lower Tank Bund in Hyderabad. The protesters strongly condemned Tata Madhu's remarks and burnt his effigy. Addressing the protest, Mahila Congress leaders said it was highly unfortunate



that a legislator, who was expected to uphold the dignity of democratic institutions, had allegedly made remarks that demeaned the constitutional office of the Assembly Speaker. They alleged that the episode once again exposed what they described as the BRS leadership's disrespectful attitude towards women and its disregard for Dalits.

Consultative Committee (DCC) and District Level Review Committee (DLRC) meeting held at the IDOC Conference Hall on Tuesday. He stressed the need for close coordination between bankers and government departments to achieve the prescribed loan targets within the stipulated time-frame. He instructed bankers to sanction loans to eligible beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana (PMDDKY) and ensure that beneficiaries make effective use of the scheme. He also called for

improved performance in sanctioning loans under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme and Kisan Credit Card (KCC) loans for fishermen. Reviewing the credit deposit position, the Collector noted that the ratio stood at 228.74 per cent as on March 31 and 227.60 per cent as on June 30. He directed banks to accelerate lending operations and improve credit deployment.

Under the priority sector, against a target of

Rs.5,743.98 crore, banks achieved Rs.3,463.10 crore (60.23 per cent) as of March 31. Against the revised target of Rs.6,495.02 crore as on June 30, only Rs.1,050.24 crore (16.17 per cent) had been achieved.

In the agriculture sector, against the March 31 target of Rs.4,979.08 crore, banks achieved Rs.3,652.98 crore (73.37 per cent). Against the June 30 target of Rs.5,575.54 crore, only Rs.990.19 crore (17.75 per cent) was achieved. The Collector instructed bankers to substantially improve the pace of agri-

agriculture loans, besides expanding banking services in rural areas. He also directed officials to conduct extensive financial literacy programmes and increase public participation in such camps.

He stressed the need to educate people about the risks and high interest burden associated with borrowing from non-banking financial institutions and private lenders. He suggested using videos, PowerPoint presentations and real-life experiences of affected borrowers to create greater awareness.
